

At a reconvened meeting of the Pulaski County Board of Supervisors held on Monday, May 27, 1991 at 7:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors meeting room of the County Administration Building, 143 Third Street, N. W. in the Town of Pulaski, the following members were present: Jerry D. White, Vice-Chairman; Bruce L. Fariss; Joseph L. Sheffey; and V. E. Vaughn. Also present were the County Attorney, Director of Management Services, and the County Administrator.

Chairman Mason Vaughan, Sr. was absent.

Vice-Chairman White presided over the meeting in Chairman Vaughan's absence.

1. Public Hearing FY 92 Budget

The County Administrator provided those in attendance with a copy of the budget advertisement, advised that the budget could be adopted seven days after completion of the hearing, which adoption is scheduled for June 3, 1991, and offered to address any questions regarding the budget proposal and preparation.

Comments on the budget were made by Mr. Colbern Linkous.

Mr. Randy Miles representing the Fairlawn Volunteer Fire Department requested authorization to develop specifications and seek bids for the fire engine pumper that is the next priority vehicle purchase on the county capital improvements plan for fire departments, but which has not been included in the current budget proposal. Mr. Miles estimated three to six months to complete the bidding process and a similar period to have delivery of the vehicle.

RE: Fairlawn Volunteer Fire Department Pumper Purchase Timing

It was moved by Dr. Fariss, seconded by Mr. Sheffey and carried, that the County Administrator be instructed to investigate timing for procurement of the proposed Fairlawn Volunteer Fire Department pumper, to determine whether procurement could begin now that would result in delivery of the vehicle and payment after July 1, 1992, to delay payment to the FY 93 fiscal year.

Voting yes: Dr. Fariss, Mr. Vaughn, Mr. White, Mr. Sheffey.

Voting no: none.

Not present: Mr. Vaughan.

Mr. Edward Campbell, representing the Pulaski County Lifesaving Crew, requested funding of a \$65,000 light duty crash truck, which is the next scheduled rescue squad vehicle purchase on the capital improvements plan, but which has not been included in the proposed FY 92 budget.

The Honorable R. Glenwood Lookabill, Circuit Court Clerk, met with the Board and explained his previously submitted written request for restoration of \$5,000 to the printing and binding line item within the Clerk's Office budget and requested \$5,598 additional dollars to complete the automated indexing of deed records from the present period back to 1964. Written explanation of these two requests are filed with the records of this meeting.

The county staff presented reallocation of the capital and operating funds for the New River Valley Airport to \$19,546 for operating expense and \$8,948 for capital expense. This reallocation does not increase the total budget proposed for the Airport Commission.

The county staff also requested a clarification of the Library budget to increase salaries and benefits by \$900, with a similar decrease in book purchases.

There being no further comments, Vice-Chairman White closed the public hearing.

2. Adjournment

It was moved by Mr. Vaughn, seconded by Mr. Sheffey and carried, that the meeting be adjourned. The next regular scheduled meeting of the Pulaski County Board of Supervisors will be on Monday, June 3, 1991 at 7:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors meeting room, County Administration Building, 143 Third Street, N. W. in the Town of Pulaski, Virginia.
