

At a reconvened meeting of the Pulaski County Board of Supervisors held on Monday, September 30, 1991 at the Dublin Branch Library in the Town of Dublin, following members were present: Mason A. Vaughan, Sr., Chairman; Jerry D. White, Vice-Chairman; Bruce L. Fariss; Joseph L. Sheffey; and V. E. Vaughn.

Also present were County Attorney Thomas J. McCarthy, Jr.; County Administrator Joseph N. Morgan; Resident Engineer J. D. Brugh; Assistant Resident Engineer John Thompson of the Virginia Department of Transportation; and Southwest Times Reporter Dee Ann Lindsey.

1. Joint Town Councils/Supervisors Meeting

The meeting was held immediately following the joint Board of Supervisors, Dublin Town Council and Pulaski Town Council meeting.

2. Work Session on Six Year Plan

The Resident Engineer and Assistant Resident Engineer met with the Board and discussed the details of the changes necessary to the six year plan to reduce those items listed on the plan submitted to the state to those that can be built within the money allocated or estimated to be allocated for the upcoming six year period.

It was moved by Dr. Fariss, seconded by Mr. Sheffey and carried, that the revised proposed six year plan as prepared by the Resident Engineer be approved for the purpose of the public hearing notice for the November 25, 1991 hearing, with the Resident Engineer to also prepare a second list of projects in need, but not fitting within the six year allocation, with that secondary list to include all road projects on the current list, as well as those additional needed projects reviewed by the Board at its September 16, 1991 meeting, plus Route 636 from its intersection with Route 639 to its intersection with Route 643.

3. Reassessment Planning - Public Hearing to be Held October 28th

The County Administrator advised the Board of the possible need for a public hearing at the October 28, 1991 meeting to consider an ordinance to establish a reassessment schedule.

It was moved by Mr. Vaughn, seconded by Mr. Sheffey and carried, that such a hearing be scheduled if needed.

4. Bond Issue Public Information Program

The Board discussed the proposed plan for public information on the proposed \$2.9 million bond issue for courthouse improvements.
