

At a reconvened meeting of the Pulaski County Board of Supervisors held on Monday, October 7, 1991 at 7:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 143 Third Street, N. W. in the Town of Pulaski, the following members were present: Mason A. Vaughan, Sr., Chairman; Jerry D. White, Vice-Chairman; Bruce L. Fariss; Joseph L. Sheffey; and V. E. Vaughn.

The invocation was given by Reverend Stuart Kelly.

1. Public Hearing - School Board Nominations

The Chairman opened a public hearing for the purpose of receiving nominations for appointment to the School Board for the vacant position representing the Massie Election District. The following nominations were made:

- a. Mr. Jack Bruce nominated Dr. Nathaniel R. Tuck.
- b. Reverend Stuart Kelly and Ms. Joan Pearman nominated Dr. Winsdon N. Pound.
- c. Mr. Wayne Ratcliff nominated Mr. Warren J. "Jeff" Bain.
- d. Sheriff Ralph Dobbins and Mr. Ray Lemons nominated Mr. Roger R. Bell, III.

Mr. Roger Bell spoke on behalf of his candidacy. Mr. Jeff Bain also spoke on behalf of his candidacy and presented a written statement.

There being no further nominations, the Chairman closed the public hearing.

Supervisor White suggested all candidates submit any additional written information desired for the Board's review by Friday, October 11th to the County Administrator's Office, in order that these materials might be forwarded to the Board members. It was the consensus of the Board to schedule interviews for each candidate at a meeting to be held on Monday, October 15th at 7:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room of the County Administration Building.

2. Other Matters

The Board was presented an update on information being provided to the public on the proposed courthouse bond issue.

Chairman Vaughan brought up for discussion the planning of the six year program for secondary road improvement. In particular, he inquired whether an improved status for Route 807, from that discussed on September 30th, might be possible. The County Administrator reported his understanding that county-wide funds might be used for paving unpaved roads. Supervisors White and Sheffey advised their understanding was that such county-wide funds could only be used for applying asphalt overlay to roads, where the road width and grade might be sub-standard, but the pavement improvements would be a general upgrade. The County Administrator was instructed to provide the Board with clarification on this matter.

The Supervisors were requested to provide information on their plans to attend the Virginia Association of Counties Annual meeting.

3. Adjournment

It was moved by Mr. Vaughan, seconded by Mr. Sheffey and carried on the following roll call vote, that the meeting be adjourned to reconvene on Tuesday, October 15, 1991 at 7:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room of the County Administration Building.
