



Ground-Breaking Ceremony: Draper Community Park

Pulaski County is excited to announce a ground-breaking ceremony for the Draper Community Park! The ceremony will be held on-site and will begin at 11:00am on Friday, August 18, 2017.

The property on which the Park is being built was previously used for Draper Elementary School and is an important gateway for the Town of Draper. It is anticipated that this Park will act as a community gathering space, as well as draw users from a wide area. The Park is intended to be inclusive and suitable for children and adults of all ages and ability levels. In addition to the Park, an existing building on the property is being renovated to house a community center, which will be operated by a volunteer committee made up of Draper residents.

When completed, the Park will have a new entrance onto Greenbriar Road, parking lot, basketball court, pavilion, playground, rejuvenated walking track, casual baseball field, and other park amenities. The County contracted with Thompson & Litton for the design and King General Contractors for the construction. Construction is anticipated to be completed within 150 days.
