'Round the Mountain is excited to be working with the Pulaski County government, the Fine Arts Center for the New River Valley, the Pulaski County Chamber of Commerce and the Radford Visitors Center on the creation of an Artisan Trail in Pulaski County and Radford city.

The Artisan Trail of Pulaski County & Radford will be linked to other local artisan trails being developed in surrounding counties to create **The Regional Artisan Trail Network**. The trail network is a major project of 'Round the Mountain -creating a network of driving trails in 19 counties and 4 cities across Southwest Virginia.

RTM is a membership organization. Artisans, farmers, agri-tourism businesses, craft venues and organizations that sell, exhibit or promote locally-made craft, art and produce are eligible for membership. The Regional Artisan Trails may include other businesses, such as restaurants or lodging, that support visitors in the community.
