2021 VITA Participation Change of Service

The Commissioner of the Revenue's partnership with New River Community Action and their Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program will be temporarily suspended for 2021 due to the coronavirus pandemic and the uncertainty it creates.

The VITA program offers free tax help for both Federal and State filing for those who qualify. In 2020 the Commissioner of the Revenue Office partnered with New River Community Action in order to bring this free income tax service to the community. We hope to provide VITA services in the future and look forward to working with participants and New River Community Action's VITA staff once we are able to accommodate.

The Commissioner's office will continue to assist in the preparation and filing of Virginia individual income tax returns for community members at no charge all year long.
