

## **Pulaski County Non-Profit Recovery Grant Program**

Our Non-Profit Community are essential to Pulaski County, and we are here to assist you with navigating through these difficult times. The Pulaski County Board of Supervisors has made available grants to support and stabilize our non-profit community and help with your recovery efforts.

Financial assistance for Pulaski County 501(c)(3) <u>and</u> 501(c)(19) non-profits impacted by COVID-19 will be made available on August 17, 2020. Pulaski County Non-Profit Recovery Grants in the amount of up to \$5,000.00 grants can be used for <u>critical</u> operating expenses to offset some of the impacts of the shutdown and aid in responding to COVID-19. Critical expenses include but are not limited to payroll, operating and reopening expenses.

## **Eligibility**

- 501(c)(3) and 501(c)(19) non-profits that are based in Pulaski County, Virginia
- 501(c)(3) and 501(c)(19) non-profits that are directly serving Pulaski County citizens
- Pulaski County 501(c)(3) and 501(c)(19) non-profits that were in operation prior to February 15, 2020
- Pulaski County 501(c)(3) and 501 (c)(19) non-profits must be registered and in good standing with the State Corporation Commission (SCC) (as applicable)
- Pulaski County 501(c)(3) and 501(c)(19) non-profits that are up to date on all Pulaski County taxes, charges and fees

A **501(c)(3) organization** is a corporation, trust, unincorporated association, or other type of organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of Title 26 of the United States Code and are organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes, for testing for public safety, to foster national or international amateur sports competition, for the prevention of cruelty to children, women, or animals.

A **501(c)(19)** is an <u>Internal Revenue Service</u> (IRS) tax exemption status that applies to veterans organizations. These organizations include "a post or organization of past or present members of the United States Armed Forces (USAF), an auxiliary unit or society of such post or organization, or a trust or foundation for such post or organization."

### **How to Apply**

The County of Pulaski will administer the program. Forms can be downloaded from the Pulaski County website at:

www.pulaskicounty.org. Applications will be accepted on a first come first served basis

starting on August 31, 2020.

NOTE: The entirety of the Pulaski County Non-Profit Recovery Grant Program is funded at a level of \$350,000.00 through a CARES Act appropriation to Pulaski County, Virginia. The program will conclude on October 30, 2020 or at which time the funds for the program have been depleted.
