

As required by the Code of Virginia, the Pulaski County Electoral Board met on November 3, 2021, at 9:10 a.m. in the Training Room/EOC adjacent to the Office of the Pulaski County Registrar for the purpose of canvassing the November 2, 2021 General and Special Election. Persons present were: Amy Lewis, Chair, Janet Johnson, Vice Chair, Sybil S. Atkinson, Secretary, Kathryn Webb, Registrar, and Maetta Crewe, Clerk of the Circuit Court. Also attending, with proper paperwork being submitted, was Matthew Wisniewski, representing the Republican Party.

The Provisional Ballot meeting was delayed until all information is received.

All 13 precincts were canvassed.

The meeting was recessed at 11:15 a.m. and will reconvene on Friday, November 5, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. for the Provisional meeting and to complete the Canvass.

The Pulaski County Electoral Board reconvened their meeting at 1:07 p.m. on November 5, 2021. Persons attending were: Amy Lewis, Chair, Janet Johnson, Vice Chair, Sybil S. Atkinson, Secretary and Kathryn Webb, Registrar, and Matthew Wisniewski, representing the Republican Party.

Motion was made by Janet Johnson to go into closed session, 24.2.653 for the purpose of the Provisional Ballot meeting and was duly seconded by Sybil Atkinson and passed unanimously.

Motion was made by Janet Johnson and seconded by Sybil Atkinson to reconvene their regular meeting and certified that only Provisional Ballot business was discussed by the Electoral Board while in closed session. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board finished the canvass of the final votes of the CAP precinct

All votes were tabulated and certified.

The Board recessed at 2:29 p.m., while all official paperwork was prepared.

The Board reconvened at 4:03 p.m.

All necessary actions were completed and there being no discrepancies, reports were filed as required by law.

Motion was made by Amy Lewis that: "Due to the increased workload, the Electoral Board determines the number of Assistant Registrars needed in the office of the General Registrar to be two full time positions. Pursuant to Section 24.2-112 of the Virginia Code." The motion was seconded by Janet Johnson and passed unanimously.

There being no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned at 4:17 p.m.
