- b. <u>Scheduling Public Hearing All Rates</u> A report will be planned for the June PSA meeting. Proposed rates will be developed to insure each solid waste cost center (residential garbage, dumpster service, roll-off service, and barrel commercial service) is self-sufficient.
- c. <u>Heron's Landing Sewer and Water Extensions</u> Phase 1 of the Heron's Landing Subdivision water and sewer facilities have been completed and <u>enclosed</u> is a deed for these improvements. There is approximately 9,120 feet of sanitary sewer line, 2,496 feet of sewer force main, 1 sewage pump station, and 8200 feet of 6" and 8" water line. The project has been constructed according to the contract documents and it is recommended the PSA accept ownership as soon as the certificate to operate is issued by the Health Department. The <u>enclosed</u> plat shows the location of lines included in this deed.
- d. <u>Billing Services Contract Town of Pulaski</u> No additional information is available at this time. Staff has received a draft agreement which is being evaluated. We expect to present a recommendation at the June PSA meeting.
- e. <u>Fontaine Modification Waterline Easement</u> I delivered a \$11,966 payment to Fontaine Modification Company for assistance with waterline relocation during the company's recent expansion; however, due to disagreement over the location of the right of way between PSA and Fontaine surveyors, I indicated the county would

require an agreement suitable to the county attorney and engineer to preserve the PSA use of the line as located. I have asked the attorney and engineer to prepare a revised easement, which the Fontaine manager, Paul Kokalis, has agreed to support

- f. <u>Draper Ridge Subdivision Water Tank</u> Subdivision developer Stanley Moran is scheduled to discuss the requirements for placement of the water tank to provide fire flow to the Draper Ridge Subdivision. A preliminary analysis indicates a payback of he investment needed to build the tank could be achieved in about ten years.

Also, authorization is requested to pay Water Treatment Plant staff for compensatory time that has exceeded 240 hours.
