- b. <u>Draper Ridge Subdivision Water Tank</u> <u>Enclosed</u> is a revised agreement for construction of the water tank to serve the Draper Ridge and Fairway Estates Subdivision. This agreement has been revised to indicate the following:
 - 1. There will be a \$2,000 surcharge placed on connections in the Draper Ridge and Fairway Estates Subdivision and on any future subdivisions that T & M Southwest may develop on adjacent property.
 - 2. There will be a \$2,000 surcharge placed on connections in the Big Valley Subdivision for lots currently owned by the original developer.
 - 3. There will be a \$15.00 per month surcharge on connections for the Draper Ridge Subdivision and Fairway Estates Subdivision
 - 4. The monthly surcharge will last for 15 years from the date of the agreement or until the cost of the tank is paid to T & M Southwest plus a 12% interest on the cost of the construction of the water tank.

The monthly surcharge or surcharge on the connection fee will not apply to lots in the Big Valley Subdivision owned by someone other than the original developer.

- c. Water Treatment Plant Staffing It is recommended that an additional Class 2 operator be employed for the Water Treatment Plant. The plant is currently operating approximately 15.5 hours daily. The current employees are accumulating the maximum number of hours for compensatory time and the holiday season is approaching when there is a large accumulation in compensatory time due to the plant operating during all holidays. The addition of a Class 2 operator will allow more flexibility in scheduling for the normal workweek and for holidays and vacations. There are currently 6 employees at the plant. The demand on the plant has increased to approximately 2 mgd and the hours of operation will require an additional operator.
