- b. <u>Town of Dublin Sewer</u> The location of the PSA offices in the Dublin Town Center resulted in a closer working relationship between the billing staffs. A result has been the discovery that the PSA was not paying the Town of Dublin for several customers in Fair Acres. <u>Enclosed</u> is a letter from Bill Parker describing the error. I have authorized payment to the Town of Dublin. Ratification is requested.
- c. <u>Hidden Valley Water & Sewer</u> The Hidden Valley Association requests individual water and sewer service to residential units on the property. The association will be responsible for debt service payment with PSA billing to the individuals at normal PSA costs. Connection fees would be based on the bulk discount as approved by the PSA Board last month. This arrangement insures the PSA will not lose any money on the project and is recommended for approval. The Association will take responsibility for the loss of any trees resulting from the construction. Service will be terminated for approximately six months per year.
- d. <u>Eagleview Sewer</u> Shawn Utt and I met with the Pulaski County Sewerage Authority this month. The Authority is considering options. Assuming the Sewerage Authority agrees to proceed, the Department of Environmental Quality requests consideration to a mutual aid agreement between the Sewerage Authority and the PSA for maintenance of pump stations. Any use of PSA staff for this purpose would be billed based on actual costs.

e. <u>Eagleview Mobile Home Park Sewer</u> – <u>Enclosed</u> is correspondence from Draper Aden Associates regarding this matter. Approval of the additional engineering costs is recommended.
